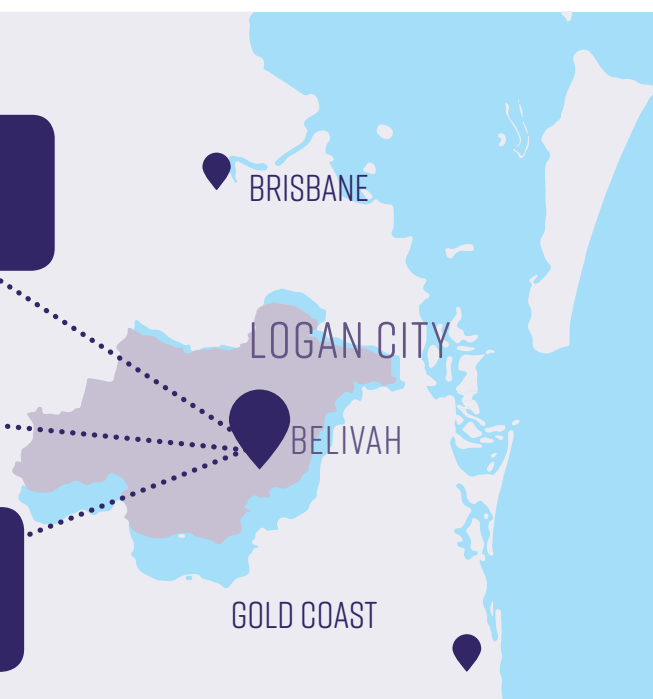

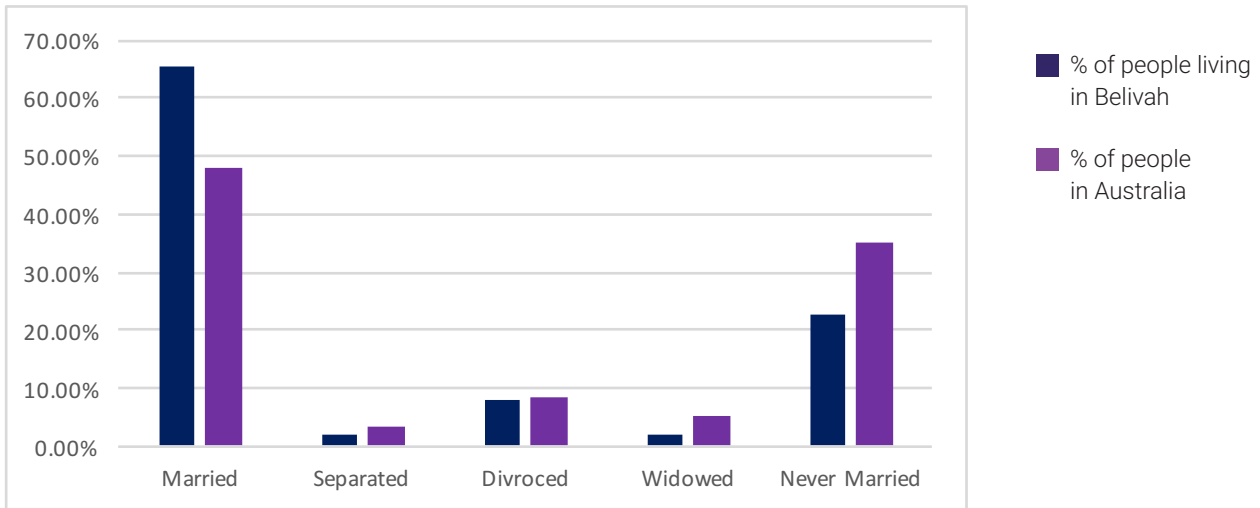

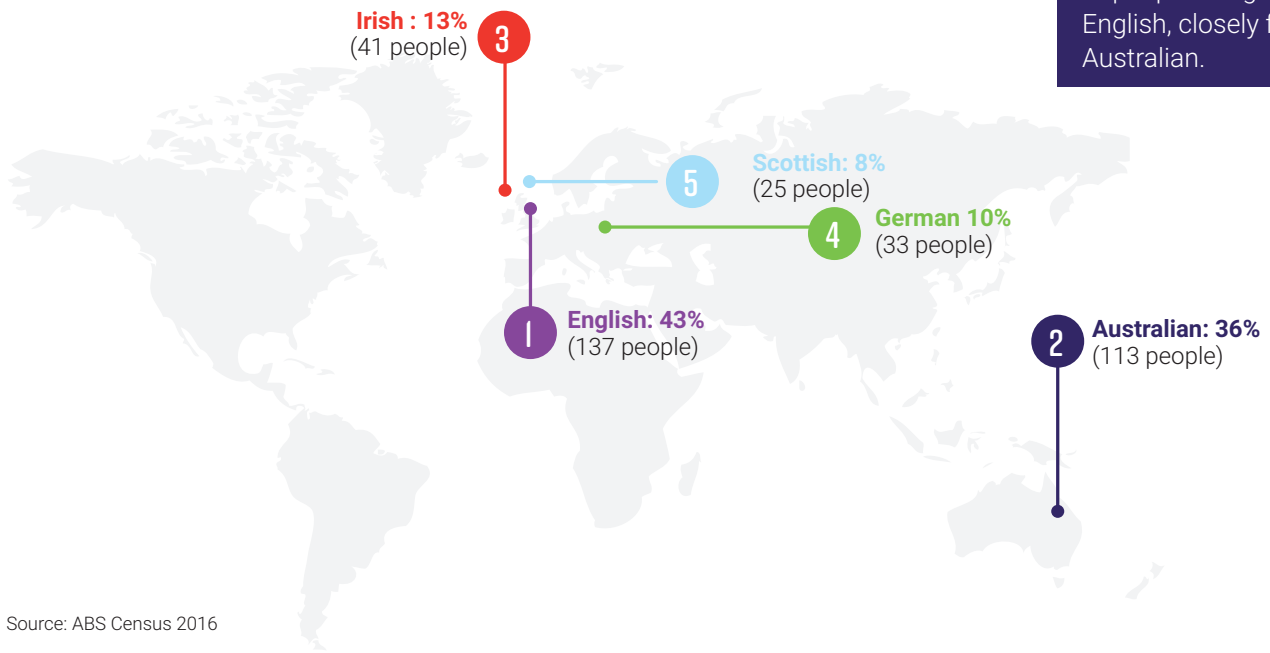
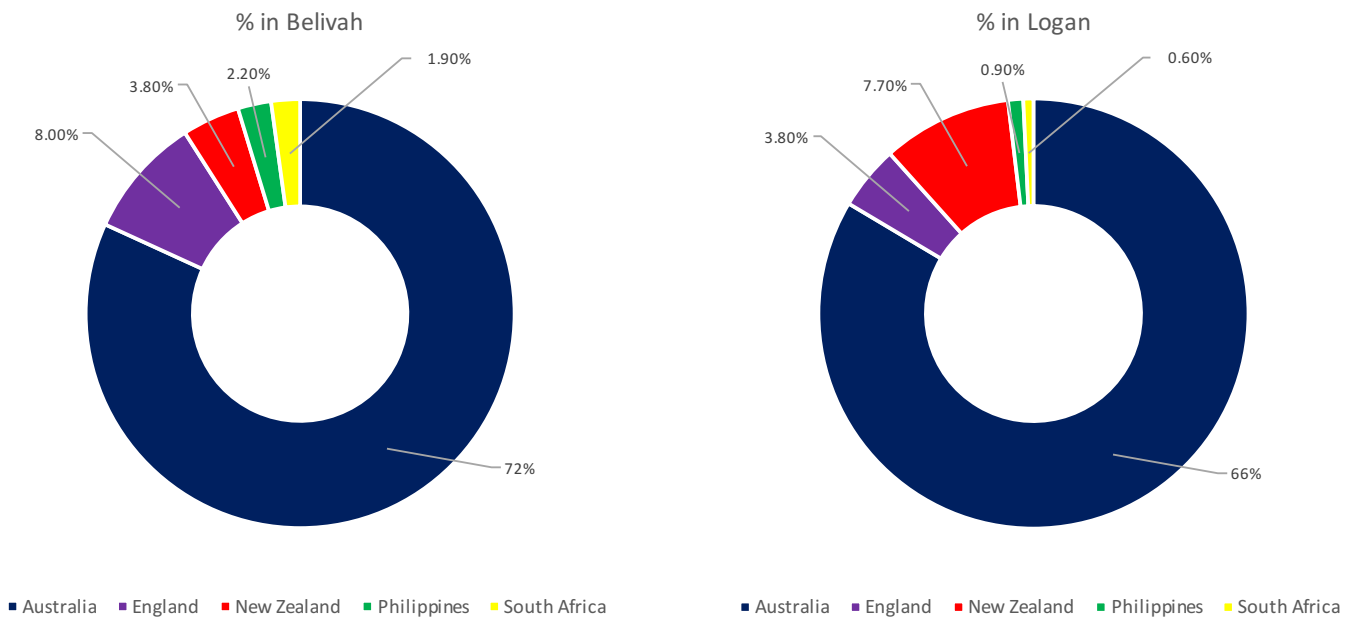


FIGURE 3: COUNTRY OF BIRTH OF PEOPLE LIVING IN BELIVAH



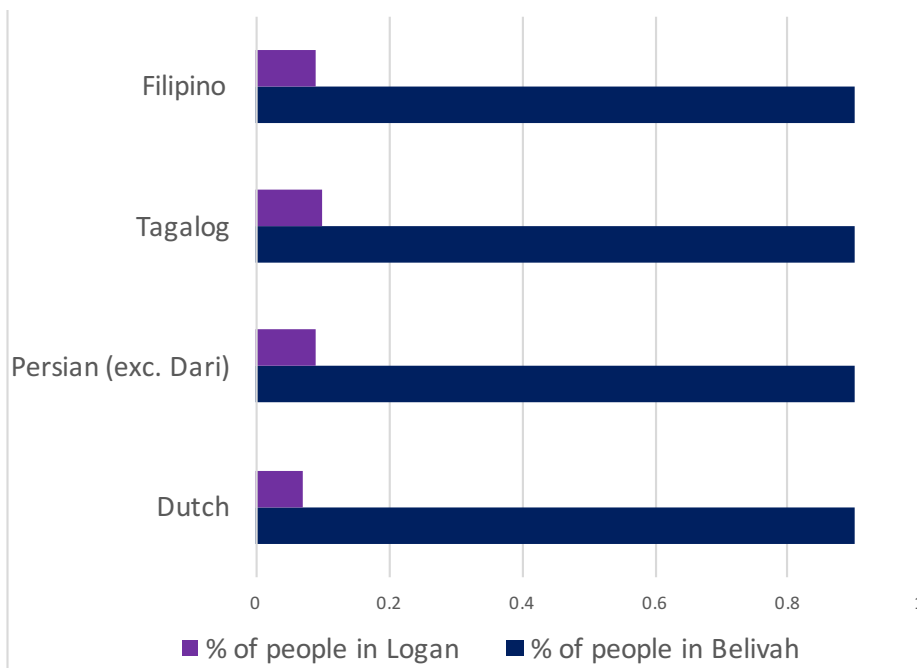

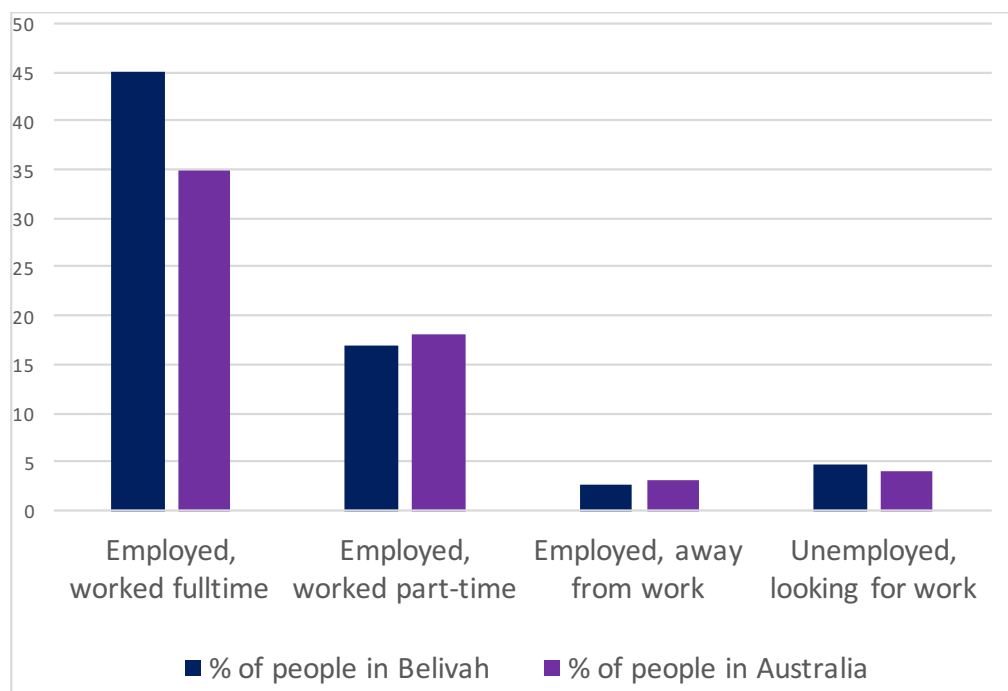

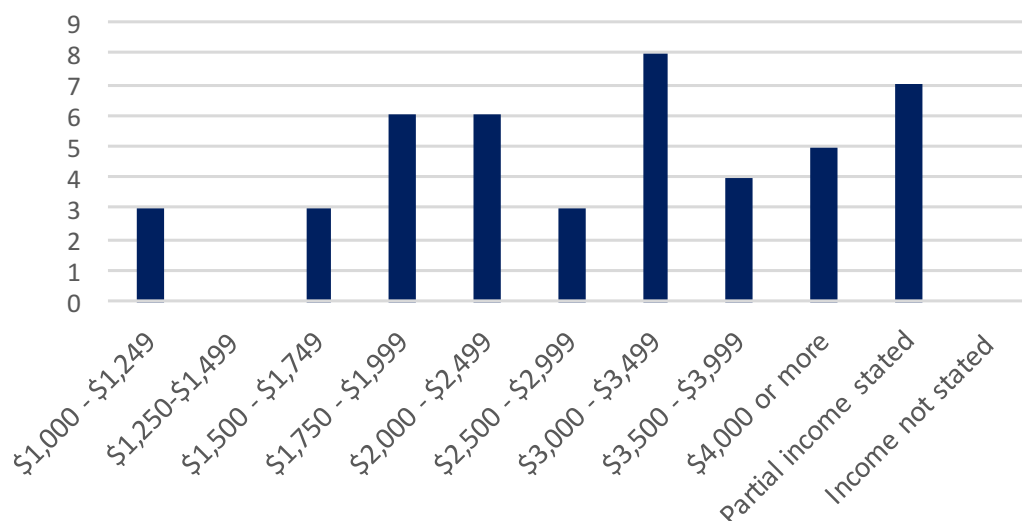

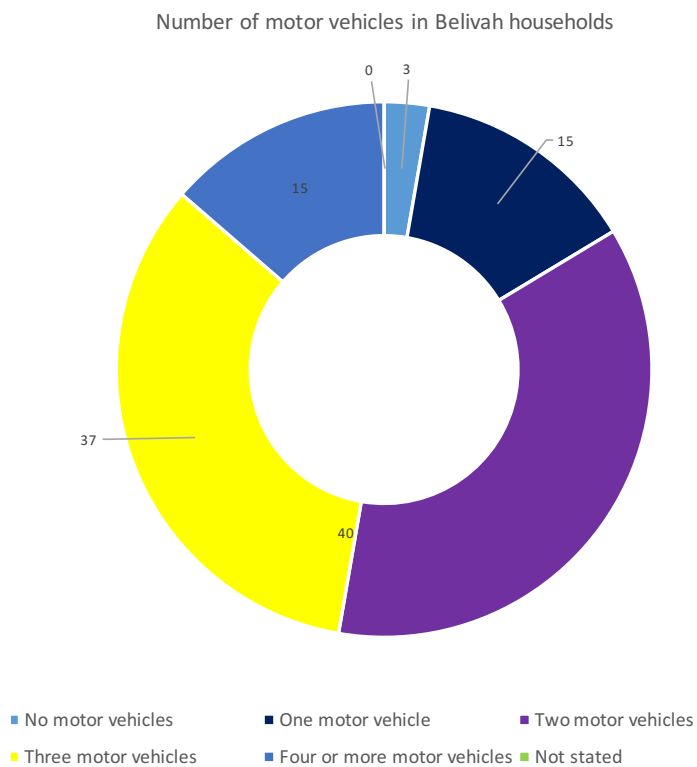
