### Roadmap Alignment: Good Start In Life, on Track at 3

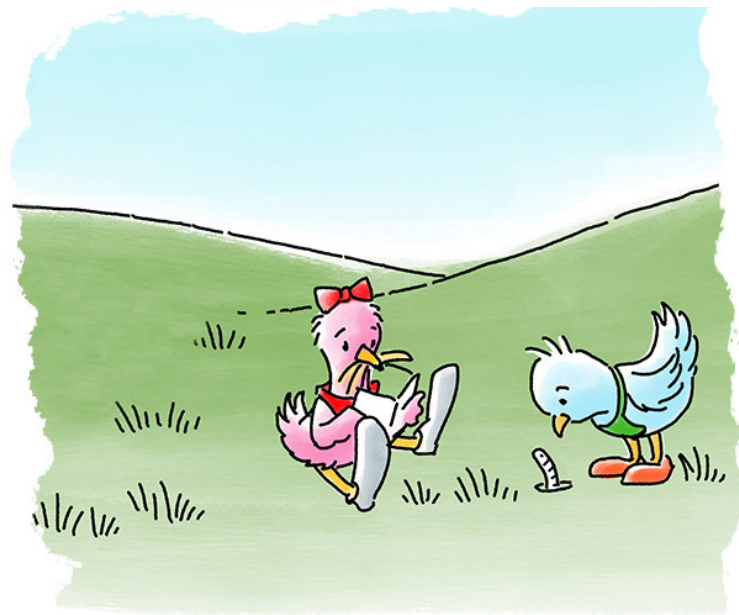
**Why it's Important** - Research the world over is telling us that the first three years of a child's life has a profound impact on their future health, development, learning and wellbeing. In particular, participation in quality early childhood education has been shown to be an important factor in overall development as well as improving children's successful transition to school.

**Aim of the Project** - To provide a strategic and co-ordinated response to delivering the necessary early childhood initiatives in Logan, which aim to boost language, literacy and brain development in babies, toddlers and young children. This project also aims to build the capacity of parents and care givers in their roles as their child's "first teacher", and are delivered from universal and welcoming community spaces.

**Partners involved** - All of the Logan Together movement has a part to play in this - including government partners, community organisations and community leaders.

**Where to from here** - The First 3 Years project will develop and implement a strategic and population level approach for delivering early childhood development initiatives in Logan, to promote healthy development, school readiness and social and emotional wellbeing in children from birth to the end of the third year of life.
