Partnership Exploration Process: Commonwealth and Qld Government	Matthew Cox referred to the Logan Together Collaboration Model and the Government Partner section which shows how the Logan Together movement engages with government. This has been occurring however it has not been in a very structured, organised way. Logan is one of 10 communities across Australia that is to be supported by the Stronger Places, Stronger People initiative. https://www.dss.gov.au/families-and-children-programs-services/stronger-places-stronger-people The

	<p>Commonwealth and State Governments are working together in regard to this initiative and State funding was included in the June budget. Other communities in Qld which are to be supported by the initiative are Rockhampton and Gladstone. At the Leadership Table meeting last week a workshop was held to discuss what we want from our government partners. It may take a few months to answer all of the questions raised. Matthew asked if the Action Group also wanted to be part of this including reviewing priorities for action at local level and considering the partnership process. Action Group members indicated they were interested in being involved. <p>Logan Together Live Register and Project Status Updates</p>	<p>Sue Jankovic presented The Logan Together Live Register and Project Status Report. Updates were provided as below.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prep to Kindy Campaign – this includes Kindy Campaign, Kindy Scholarships, Kindy Programs – Bespoke Options, Positive Start to School Initiative and Enrol to Prep Campaign and these have now been entered on the Live Register and Project Status Report. • Logan’s Little Learner has been added to the Live Register. Marnie Julin from First Five Forever is leading this project. • Domestic & Family Violence School Workforce Development Project. Rebecca Maurer and Sunanda Prakash were unable to attend today’s meeting but have provided the following report. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Presenters: Sunanda Prakash (DFV Child Protection Practitioner, High Risk Team), Tegan Jefferys (DFV Specialist, UCC IFSS Logan), Larissa Shaw (DFV Specialist, FACC Logan Benevolent Society) and Trudi Peters (Manager Domestic and Family Violence, Student Protection) ✓ It was agreed that the presentation would occur through a webinar forum which was QLD Education Blackboard Collaboration. The webinar was recorded and a link developed which can be shared to support other staff to be briefed on how to respond to DFV and what supports are available. The presentation was an hour long. ✓ Contents of presentation: Training considerations; Training objectives; What is DFV?; DFV Facts; Forms of abuse – strategies used by perpetrators; Duluth Power and Control Wheel; Gendered Violence; Government’s response to DFV – key policies and strategies; What are the High Risk Teams and Integrated Service Responses; How do Schools Fit In?; Indicators of DV; Common Risk Assessment and Managements – QLD Common Risk and Safety Framework; Responding to Disclosures; Reporting Suspected Harm to Students; Information Sharing; Respectful Relationships Education; Practical Support for Employees Affected by DFV; FaCC Support; IFSS Support ✓ Each presenter spoke to sections of the presentation. Opportunity for questions was present throughout. <p>As this specific project is now completed the Action Group will consider if there is further work we want to do in this area. To do this we will run an action focussed workshop with consideration to include the information we have already collated from a number of previous discussions about this. If anyone has ideas for a facilitator for that workshop let Ellen Ferris know.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Father Engagement – Michael Jacobs provided an update including information from Glenn Hodgson.

- ✓ The Logan Men's Network is meeting on 27 August at 12:30 pm at The Family Place for information sharing and to discuss any collaborative opportunities.
- ✓ *Man With A Pram* activity is on Sunday 1 September – 8.30 am – 1.30 pm at Brisbane City Botanic Gardens, if you could please promote it that would be great. If you would like to participate, please let me know.
- ✓ In collaboration with Dads Group Inc Glenn Hodgson has started a Facebook page called Dads of Logan <https://www.facebook.com/groups/262735844300133> He is wanting to prepare some content before active promotion and is interested to hear of any ideas for what to include e.g. local activities, jokes, information about men's groups.
- ✓ Glenn has been speaking with someone who is looking for a male to deliver a men's self-improvement program in the evening. It's a paid position for three hours per week for the length of the course. Ideally the person would have had some experience in delivering similar programs. If anyone knows of a suitable person please let Glen know.
- ✓ Domestic and Family Violence has been an issue for the Men's Network. There is a good 10 week program *Circuit Breaker*, presented by Matt Boulton on Monday nights at KENG. This program has been very successful. Matt Boulton has previously presented to the Action Group.
- ✓ Good things are happening with the Dad's in Distress program including helping people going through court process and helping men to take the next positive step.
- ✓ Great Mates meet every Friday morning at KENG. This has been very successful.
- ✓ 1st Step Program run in connection with PCYC.
- ✓ Saturday at The Family Place – Dad's play group and men's group.
- ✓ Yolanda van Gellecum asked about the impact assessment of the Circuit Breaker program. Also Grainne Taia asked about funding as it would be great to have interpreters so CALD people can participate. Michael advised that KENG has helped and he is also looking for more funding with a view to roll out the Circuit Breaker program on a larger scale and also running Facilitator training.
- ✓ Sue Jankovic suggested that we connect with Sharon to showcase some of this work.
- Sue mentioned that there were two projects identified as slightly off track – Community Gateways which will be back on track soon and NDIS which is still off track. Also Sue referred to the two greyed out items on the agenda – Going to Kindy and Enrol in Prep Campaign and YFS Thriving Families which are to be included as agenda items for a future Warril Yari-Go meeting. Sue – will continue to maintain the Live Register.
- Christine Grose advised that the Thriving Families program is now open for referrals.

Actions: Ellen Ferris is to re-circulate the information from previous discussions about Domestic and Family Violence. Michael Jacobs is to connect with Sharon Worboys in regard to showcasing some of the work done in relation to Father Engagement.
