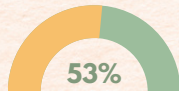

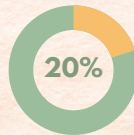

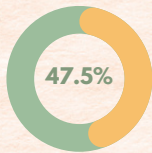

In 2024, 47.5% children started school **developmentally on track in all domains** in Yarrabilba

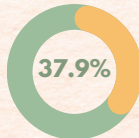
